

## **Nova Scotia Union of Public & Private Employees Bursary Application 2023**

The Nova Scotia Union of Public & Private Employees (NSUPE) will award six bursaries of \$1,000 each. Bursaries will be awarded based on a random draw that will take place at NSUPE's biennial Convention on November 17, 2023. The deadline to submit an application is November 10, 2023

To be eligible for a bursary, applicants must be a NSUPE member in good-standing or the spouse or dependent of a NSUPE member in good-standing. There may only be one winner per each NSUPE member.

Before receiving a bursary, winners will be required to:

- Provide proof of current enrollment at a post-secondary education program
- Write a 500 to 1,000-word essay on "Why unions are important in 2023"
- Consent to their names and photographs being used for promotional purposes on the NSUPE website and on social media.
